Thank you for your invitation for Nike to attend a Workers' Rights Board event regarding Honduras to be held on Tuesday April 27th.

We understand your concerns regarding this issue. And, while we appreciate the offer to engage at your event, an open hearing where Nike has been asked to testify is not the most effective forum for constructive dialogue with the Honduran workers. As such we will be declining the offer to attend the April 27th hearing.

Nike will be reaching out to USAS and the two worker representatives from Honduras to offer to meet with them while they are in Portland. We are open and receptive to hearing their concerns and believe a constructive conversation would be beneficial to both parties.
